Planning Board Associate Member Vacancy

The Town of Freetown Planning Board is currently accepting letters from interested applicants to fill a vacancy for an Associate Member on the Planning Board. The Planning Board and the Board of Selectmen will be jointly appointing an Associate member to serve until the end of the fiscal year (June 30, 2024) and who may be reappointed for one-year terms.

The Planning Board is an elected body created for the purpose of protecting the safety, convenience, and welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Freetown by regulating the laying out and construction of ways in subdivisions and for ensuring compliance with the Town of Freetown zoning by-laws. The responsibilities of the Associate Member are to act on any Special Permit Applications when there is not a quorum of elected members. The Board generally meets the first and third Tuesday of each month.
