Instructions for Completing this Application

1. **Voter Information** – Provide your name, the address where you are registered to vote, your ballot mailing address (if different) and date of birth.
2. **Ballot Information** – If you are applying for a Vote by Mail ballot for a primary and are not registered in the Democratic, Libertarian or Republican Party, be sure to choose a ballot. If you are registered in the Democratic, Libertarian or Republican Party, you can only receive that Party's ballot. If you do not select a ballot, a ballot will not be sent to you for the indicated Primary.
3. **Assistance** – If you are helping someone complete this application, or if you are requesting a ballot for a family member, fill out this section.
4. **Sign your name** – If you cannot sign your name, you may ask someone to sign your name in your presence.

Application Deadlines

To receive a ballot for the noted Elections, this application *must* be received by the Elections Department/Office of the Town Clerk (address above) by 5 p.m. on following days:

- Presidential Primary** – Tuesday, February 27, 2024
- Annual Local Town Election** – Monday, March 25, 2024
- State Primary** – Monday, August 26, 2024
- Presidential Election** – Tuesday, October 29, 2024

As of January 1, 2023, the Board of Registrars/Elections Department is required by law to include this Vote by Mail application in all voter registration acknowledgment mailings.

Notes about Vote by Mail Applications:

- In the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Vote by Mail applications are only good for the calendar year in which they are received.
- If you have already returned a Vote by Mail application or postcard to get a Vote by Mail ballot from the Town of Freetown for all elections in 2024, you do not need to return this application again.
- If you are moving from another community, applications do not travel with you to your new community – you will need to re-apply in your new community if you wish to receive a Vote by Mail ballot. Please return this paper application in order to receive your mailed ballot from the Town of Freetown.
- Vote By Mail ballots for the Presidential Primary or State Primary:
 - If you are enrolled in the Democratic, Libertarian or Republican Party, you will receive that party-specific ballot automatically. If you are registered as UNENROLLED or in a political designation, you *must* select which party's ballot you wish to receive (Democratic, Libertarian or Republican), or else no Primary ballot will be sent to you.

2024 Election Schedule

Presidential Primary – Tuesday, March 5, 2024

In-Person Early Voting will be available February 24-March 1, 2024.

Annual Local Town Election – Monday, April 1, 2024

In-Person Early Voting is not an option for this election.

State Primary – Tuesday, September 3, 2024

In-Person Early Voting will be available August 24-28, 2024. Details forthcoming.

Presidential Election – Tuesday, November 5, 2024

In-Person Early Voting will be available October 19-November 1, 2024. Details forthcoming.
