Absentee Ballot Voting is available for use by:

- 1) A registered voter who is absent from the voter's city or town during normal polling hours; or
- 2) A registered voter with a physical disability that prevents them from going to the polling place; or
- 3) A registered voter is unable to go to the polls because of religious beliefs;
- 4) A non-registered voter who is absent from the state; or
- 5) A non-registered voter who is an active member of the armed forces or merchant marines, their spouse or dependent; or
- 6) A non registered voter who is confined in a correctional facility or a jail, except if by reason of felony conviction.
