Notice is hereby given that NSTAR Elective d/b/a EVERSOURCE ENERGY request permission to locate poles, wires, cables and fixtures including the necessary anchors, guys and other such sustaining and protecting fixtures to be owned and used in common by your petitioners, along and across the following public way or ways:

Ridge Hill Rd:

To place (1) jointly owned pole on Ridge Hill Rd., opposite #24 Alexandra Way, southeast of existing Pole 89/0.5to support the installation of additional electric company equipment.

NECESSITY – Pole placement to support the installation of additional electric company equipment.

Wherefore they pray that after due notice and hearing as provided by law, they be granted joint or identical locations for and permission to erect fixtures as they may find necessary, said poles to be erected substantially in accordance with the plan filed herewith marked-VZ N.E. Inc. Plan No MA2022-074 dated February 4, 2022.

Also, for permission to lay and maintain underground laterals, cables and wires in the above intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and building as each of said petitioners may desire for distributing purposes.

Your petitioners agree that space shall be reserved and maintained for the limited purpose of attaching one-way low voltage fire and police signaling wires owned by the municipality or governmental entity for public safety purposes only.

A hearing to consider the above will be held on Monday, March 28, 2022, at 7:00pm at the Police Station Community Room, 15 Memorial Drive, East Freetown, Massachusetts.
