MINUTES OF MEETING OF MONDAY NOVEMBER 17, 2014

Call to Order

Public Hearing: In conjunction with the Board of Assessors relative to selection of the residential factor to determine the percentage of the tax burden to be borne by each class of property.

Sheila Scaduto of the Board Of Assessors is here to assist the Board Of Selectman with the Classification Hearing for FY15. Mrs. Scaduto shares items with the Board tonight they are a Classification Sheet, a Historic Items resulting in a Tax Shifts Sheet, and a What If Scenario Sheet. The Classification Sheet compares last year's values with this year's new Fiscal Year values. Mrs. Scaduto continues to read from the sheet she has distributed. The values have not been certified by the Department of Revenue as well as the Fiscal Year 15 new growth. Selectman Pacheco asks about the anticipation of new growth. Mrs. Scaduto says as she continues it will show. CIP increased by 9.8% FY15 new growth \$618,668. \$383,652 is from industrial and \$54,602 is from personal property. And there is excess levy capacity at approx \$332,502.38. Selectman Baumgartner asks how we know the growth. Mrs. Scaduto says look at FY14 compared to the FY15 levy which is 7.5% and then the average of the two which is 4.4%. Selectman Baumgartner says then this is because of the solar. Mrs. Scaduto explains the rest of the FY15 Shift Scenario sheet. Selectman Sadeck asks about the assessed value of the single family and why it has gone up? Scaduto says it had gone up because the sales that have occurred are commanding a higher price. Values are stabilizing and increasing. Mrs. Scaduto says this year there was nothing remarkable except for industrial growth. Commercial is lagging behind. Motion (Sadeck/Baumgartner) to continue with the shift of 1.43. Passed unanimously.
