

The meeting for the Cemetery Board of the Town of Freetown was held on Tuesday evening, June 20, 1995 at 7:00 PM at the home of Mrs. Robert C. Parker. Posted as handicapped accessible - anyone welcome. Ralph Huiney, Harris Chase and Harriett Parker all present. Mrs. Eleanor Chase attended as interested party.

The minutes of the ~~minutes~~ meeting of March 2, 1995 were read and approved. There were no changes or additions. Also reviewed the Rogers-Savage Lot problem, our visit there as of May 21, and gave each a copy of last letter to their lawyer. We ~~for~~ have not heard since my letter of 5/21/95.

We discussed the work done at the various cemeteries and their appearance for Memorial Day, Mother's Day and in general. Mrs. Parker said she would prepare a list

of cemeteries we are involved with and where our responsibility begins and ends as she understands it. Copies to Harris & Ralph and with cemetery files.

Discussed end of the fiscal year funds - bills. All must be turned in for processing by Town Accountant by July 15th. (Expenditure through 5/31/95). T.C. Funds may be spent at any time. Mrs. Parker suggested we spend some time in the future reviewing the use of funds and where we are and if we are overspending. What is the Town's obligation?

Discussion was held of forthcoming Town Meeting to be held on June 26th, 1995 at Apponaug. We are asking for ~~15~~ \$5,000.00 of our 2,000+ gained from sale of cemetery lots to be transferred to us by the Town meeting for use in preparing new sections of the cemetery and for improving roads and some surveying. This money must be spent on cemeteries.

Ralph Hurney had had a question concerning the fact that there were no veterans flags at the Evans Cemetery. He referred them to the officers of the American Legion, V.F.W. or the graves registration officer, Sam Ferry.

We touched on some of the private cemeteries over which we have no control. Are we interested in doing anything there? Is the Town interested? It was suggested that

Selectman John Ashley might have some inputs
Especially on the South Cemetery on W. Boley Road.

After the Town Meeting on June 26, 1995 we can
start working on our various projects. Must
remember to straighten out Pittsley Lane on
South edge - the OLD 19.

Our next meeting will be held on July
