

Meeting of Cemetery Board

A meeting of the Board of Cemetery Commissioners for the Town of Freetown was held on Tuesday evening, July 11, 1995 at 7:00 PM at the home of Mrs. Robert C. Parker, 15 Chase Road in East Freetown. Present were Ralph Starkey, Harris Chase and Hamitt Parker. Eleanor Chase and James Starkey also attended. Date & time of meeting had been posted at Town Hall and was in the V.B Standard Times.

The minutes of the meeting of June 20th were read and approved.

We discussed the East Freetown Cemetery on Chase Road which we have the care of. The condition of the right-of-way into it is not good. We thought we might discuss this with Dennis Demoruelle as he used to get to some of his farm activities. Post road name is Hog Lane. We would have to ask for Town money and take it through a Town Meeting to get funds. Michael keeps it in good shape though with limited funds.

We voted to have David Cox finish Section 14 and start to straighten out the Pittsley Lots in the 1st 19. Also have him mark out the two Lavin lots as Harris has a foundation to put in. After he has looked over the old 19, we will probably have to talk to Miriam Pittsley & brothers. Stake out Leonard Pittsley's & notify him.

Talk to Marc about the snow on the Bobbitt Lot. We will trim it as we feel taking it out will disturb stones. It's a nice shrub. Notify the owner.

We need to talk to Dan & Cass about what we have left for roads & where to enlarge. Can we go from Section 22 - one block South, avoiding grades already there?

We spent down all appropriated monies and bills went in before deadline in July.

Harris & Ralph will look into what we can do with our \$5000. that was appropriated at Town Meeting on June 26th.
(Roads - Surveying - Clearing) Joe Simmons, David Cass & Marc St. Hilaire may be consulted.

The next meeting will be on August 15th, 1995 at 7:00 P.M. here again.
