

MINUTES-FREETOWN CEMETERY COMMITTEE May 18, 1978

The meeting of the Freetown Cemetery Committee was called to order at 7:30 P.M. Members present were Ben Charland, Robert Parker, and Harris Chace.

The first item on the agenda was the assignment of services to the surveyor Mr. David Cass, who was hired with the remaining revenue sharing funds of a previous year, totaling \$380.61. Mr. Cass informed the members that his rate was \$15.00 per hour for two men and a truck plus equipment.

Aerial photos of the proposed area to be surveyed and plotted were shown and the details of the lay-out were suitably described and the task outlined.

In response to a request for more adequate floral displays to be provided on graves so designated in the P.C. accounts, it was voted that the Chairman would establish a procedure and bidding process to provide for this service in the future. It will be brought before the committee for their consideration at the next meeting.

The recording of the sale of a 2 grave lot to Hubert Leary of 7 Hollywood Avenue, Assonet, was duly recorded as lot number 35-B, Section 18 in the Town Clerks' office book 33, Page 1.

The sum of \$350.00 was deposited with the Treasurers office.

The motion was made and carried to adjourn at 9:00 P.M.
