

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

In accordance with the Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. Ch. 131, §40) you are hereby notified of a public hearing.

The Freetown Conservation Commission will hold a hearing on Monday, July 29, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. in the Freetown Town Hall, 3 North Main Street, Assonet to review a **Notice of Intent** as follows:

- Submitted by:** Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation
- Represented by:** Shaun Provencher, DCR Land Protection Planner
- Scope of Work:** Trail construction, wetland crossing, and stream crossing work to open the Proprietors Way Conservation Project up to public use on trails less than 36" wide open to non-motorized use. These trails qualify as "Minor Activity in the Buffer and Riverfront Area" under 310 CMR 10.02(2)(b)2.a.
- Location:** Proprietors Way (from Chace Road to Lakeville Town Line) and lots adjacent thereto.

All persons, parties, or corporations interested therein may appear and be heard in relation thereto.
