

EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

Town of Freetown public safety officials are able to use an Emergency Notification System known as the “Communicator” to notify residents of various emergencies and urgent situations such as:

- Missing Persons;
- Fugitive(s);
- Hazardous Materials;
- Evacuations;
- Traffic emergencies;
- Terrorist and Bomb threats;
- Natural or man-made disasters such as floods, hurricanes, earthquakes, tornadoes & explosions;
- Public health threats such as contaminated drinking water, infectious disease outbreaks; rabid animals;
- Vicious/Aggressive animals loose on a street or in a neighborhood; and
- Serious incidents potentially dangerous to the public.

This Emergency Notification System “Communicator” is used by communities throughout Bristol and Plymouth Counties and is administered by the Plymouth County Sheriff’s Office.
