This would need to be done in a timely matter to continue the progression of the work. Also Mary would like ideas from members for commercial lights for the interior perimeter of the bandstand and flat ceiling lights.
 - C. Washburn Road house – The people who were planning on purchasing are no longer interested in the property. The property is up for sale once again and may have enough land for two houses.
