



Article Number Subject Matter of Proposed Amendments Sufficient for Identification

Zoning Proposal: To amend the FEMA Floodplain Overlay District Zoning to make them current. The Floodplain District includes all special flood hazard areas designated as Zones A and AE on the Bristol County Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) issues by FEMA for the administration of the National Flood Insurance Program. The map panels of the Bristol County FIRM that are wholly or partially within the Town of Acushnet are panel numbers 25005C0293F, 25005C0294F, 25005C0337F, 25005C0381F, 25005C0382F, 25005C0384, 25005C0392F, 25005C0403F, 25005C0411F, 25005C0 dated July 7, 2009; and panel numbers 25005C0383G dated July 16, 2014.

The FIRM and Flood Insurance Study report are incorporated herein by reference, and may be viewed at the Town Building Official's and Conservation Commission's offices, and documents and postings can be viewed at the Town Clerk's office, all during regular business hours.
