Scope of Work: After-the-fact filing for trail repairs on Landon Hill Path off Makepeace Road, work having consisted of repairing a two-wheeled motorized trail loop using the "turnpike" technique for crossing low, wet areas by installing 250 feet of five-foot-wide turnpike on an existing degraded and braided trail route.

Location: Landon Hill Path off Makepeace Road, Assonet
Assessors' Map 216, Lot 20
Specific area located between intersections TB8 and TB9 on the "Southeastern Massachusetts Bioreserve" map.
