

## **Notice to Freetown Residents and Businesses**

For the six month period from January 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016, we have enjoyed lower costs for electricity as a result of the aggregation and joint purchase of the power use in 23 cities and towns in the Southeast Massachusetts area, including Freetown. Eversource's rate during this six-month period has been \$0.1080. Our two-year fixed rate is \$0.0949 per kilowatt hour (kWh), a savings of \$0.0131 per kWh.

Eversource's rate, beginning July 1, 2016, through December 30, 2016, will drop to \$0.08208 kWh, \$0.01282 kWh lower than the Aggregation rate for the second six-month period.

You may be thinking of going back to Eversource to save a little over a penny per kWh on your bill. Before you do, please consider the information contained in the attached video and Rate Projection Chart, and contact me if you have any questions.

Our Aggregation rate is fixed at 9.49¢ for a full 24-month period, through December 30, 2017. Eversource's rates are projected to jump to over 10¢ again in January, as they did last January. The Aggregation fixed rate provides you with stability as opposed to Eversource's wildly fluctuating rates, and also save you a significant amount of money over the 24 month period.
