FINAL VOTER REGISTRATION and/or Change of PARTY ENROLLMENT for the September 8, 2016 STATE PRIMARY Election

FINAL VOTER REGISTRATION – This session is being held for residents who have not yet registered to vote and wish to be eligible to vote in the upcoming State Primary (9/8/16) or want to change their party enrollment. **The Final Voter Registration will be held at the Town Clerk's Office in the Town Hall, located at 3 North Main St., Assonet from 9AM – 8PM on Friday, August 19, 2016.** Registrations are also accepted Monday – Thursday at the Town Clerk's Office between the hours of 9AM-4PM and Friday, 9AM-12Noon.

Residents may register to vote online or download a fillable registration form at <http://www.sec.state.ma.us/ele/eifev/howreg.htm> Residents registering to vote or changing their party enrollment using mail-in forms, must have their forms postmarked no later than August 19th in order to vote in the September 8th State Primary Election. No names can be added to the voter list and no party enrollment changes can be made except to correct omissions made by clerical error or mistake after 8PM on the final voter registration date.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS - These ballots are available at the Town Clerk's Office and are for residents who are registered to vote on or before the August 19th deadline. To qualify to vote by absentee ballot the voter has to be unable to vote at the polls on election day due to the absence from town when the polls are open or have a physical disability preventing them from going to the polls. Applications requesting an absentee ballot may be filed until 12Noon on September 7, 2016.
