MINUTES

Jan. 12, 1978

The Freetown Cemetery Committee met in the Town Hall at 7:00 P.M.

Present were: Robert Parker, Benoit H. Charland.

First item taken up was the payment of the Care and Maintenance for the White Cemetery, Keene Road, East Freetown. Submitted by Eleanor Townsend, these bills were for the year 1976 & 1977. It has never been the custom of this Board to sign such a bill from the White Cemetery, however, at the request of the Town Treasurer, it was voted to approve and sign these bills for payment as of this date.

Second item of discussion concerned review of present budget balance. It was noted that in Account No. 5012.40360 the sum of \$380.61 remained from the Revenue Sharing of previous years for Cemetery Survey. Motion was made and seconded and passed that contact be made with Town Surveyor to have new plot surveyed as soon as possible.

Remaining Anti-recession monies for Building & Road Repairs to be taken up at a later meeting.

Third item: Preparation of Fiscal Year '79 Budget. After reviewing present line items in present budget and finding a \$333.70 deficiency in the first 6 months of this year's budget, it was moved and passed that the Perpetual Care account line item for fiscal year 1979 be raised to the sum of \$5,450. That the maintenance account be combined into one account to read:

Freetown Cemeteries:	<u>Maintenance</u>	=	\$1,300
	<u>General Care</u>		

Discussion lead to the moving and passing of additional new funds to be requested in fiscal year 1979 Budget for the purpose of oiling and sanding existing roads the sum of \$3,000 to be needed. For the purpose of establishing new roads in the newly developed lot area \$3,000 to be needed. Total Budget request for Fiscal Year 1979:
