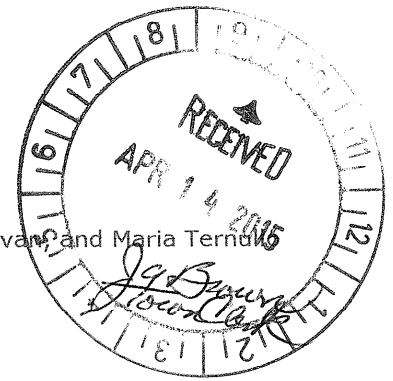


**Freetown Conservation Commission**  
Minutes of the Monday, September 8, 2014 Meeting  
Town Hall, 3 North Main Street, Assonet, Mass.



**Present:** Keven Desmarais, Christopher Mather, Janine Robidoux, Charles Sullivan, and Maria Terndrup

**Call to order:** Keven Desmarais called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

**Request for Determination of Applicability – Route 24 (half-mile north of Exit 10), Assonet**

David Paulson of the Mass. Division of Fisheries & Wildlife was present to discuss the project. The proposal seeks to use a chemical application to kill certain invasive plants disturbing a fern area. Two treatments would be necessary in the fall, done by a licensed applicator.

A motion was made by Mrs. Robidoux, seconded by Mr. Sullivan, to issue a negative determination #2. The motion carried unanimously.

**Abbreviated Notice of Resource Area Delineation – 0 Slab Bridge Road, Assonet**

A motion was made by Mrs. Robidoux, seconded by Mr. Sullivan, to waive the reading of the public hearing notice. The motion carried unanimously.

Jean Briggs and Bob Danielson were present to discuss the project. There are 2,000 feet of isolated land subject to flooding, the majority of which is on Lot 23. Commissioners opted to schedule a site walk for 12:00 noon on September 19th.

A motion was made by Mr. Mather, seconded by Mr. Sullivan, to continue the hearing to September 22nd. The motion carried unanimously.

**Request for Determination of Applicability – 106½ Dr. Braley Road, East Freetown**

Evan Watson was present to discuss the project, consisting of installing a small solar array in an area previously used for the storage of sand.

A motion was made by Mrs. Robidoux, seconded by Mr. Sullivan, to issue a negative determination #3, with the conditions that (1) a siltation control barrier be installed where appropriate and (2) a seed mix appropriate to solar arrays be used. The motion carried unanimously.

**Request for Determination of Applicability – 25 Marie's Way, East Freetown**

The proposed project consists of a 26 x 45 garage.

A motion was made by Mrs. Robidoux, seconded by Mr. Mather, to issue a negative determination #3, contingent on submitting updated plans. The motion carried unanimously.

**Correspondence**

A letter was received from Boy Scout Troop 333 of Cathedral Camp discussing erosion problems at the boat ramp. All felt this was a good project for the Boy Scouts to tackle.

**Pay Bills**

A motion was made by Mr. Sullivan, seconded by Mr. Mater, to pay all bills. The motion carried unanimously.
