

Minutes of meeting hold on February 6, 2017 at the Freetown Council on Aging. Meeting opened at 10:30 AM.

Chairperson Edward Medeiros introduced the Superintendent of Schools Rick Medeiros and Business Manager Fred Baker. Mr. Medeiros and Mr. Baker gave handouts, and presented a brief explanation of the school budget. A question and answer period followed.

Old Business:

New Business:

Board reviewed the 2018 budget and Director Barbara Lafleur explained the breakdown. Motion made to accept the 2018 budget by Jeannette Tisdelle and seconded by Ruth Ferland.

PT Cruiser- some recent problems; rotors for the front brakes for safety purposes and gas tank problem solved.

Fujitsu A/C units- Building will be measured for upstairs and downstairs, the estimate will be given to the Building Department for this expense.

<u>Programs:</u> Volunteers will be asked to knit scarves for children, AARP will be doing taxes for seniors, free of charge beginning on February 15, 2017. This program is offered by Volunteers who have been trained by the AARP.
