Call to Order 10:04 AM

Treasurer Report-

Old Business:

Walk in refrigerator/freezer-waiting on the electric to be fixed. Articles were taken off the warrant that would have helped with this. Bruce Wilbur and Jeannette Tisdelle have been inquiring about this. Robin Kendrick suggests writing a letter with our concerns. Charles Gray said 400 amp service can be installed in a day. Bruce mentioned facilities account. Jeannette has asked Jeff Chandler, Building Department to call her.

Storage Lights-The lights are installed, electric cannot be done until it is fixed in the building first.

Grocery Room-Shelving has been done.

Bingo Cards-still looking into this.

Cameras-Grant money will be used for this. We have 2 estimates, Bruce is calling to get another one, as one might be out of date to use.

Tables-Jeannette Tisdelle is looking into this. She has made some phone calls and not getting good responses back. She will contact the school department to see if she can receive information that might be useful at the senior center.

FY 2020-Bruce Wilbur and Jeannette Tisdelle went to the Selectmen and Finance Meeting. Questions were asked about the grant we have available.

Grant-We have the approval to purchase new desks, phone system, camera surveillance system, fax machine, computers and tables. We are getting our

estimates together and will revise the grant for those items then we can purchase.

Lucky Charms-We sent our request to them requesting new garden beds.

Raised Garden Beds-The old ones are broken and falling apart will be taken down by the Highway Department. We are looking into galvanized ones.
