### **New Bingo Cards:**

**Some cards we have are over 10 years old. After much discussion the board voted to purchase new cards.**

### **Repair/Replace pool table cloth:**

**At this time, it does not need to be replaced. This pool table is used at least 3 days a week. Some are here in the morning and others will use it again in the afternoon. We will check into this again in April.**

***COA/Library: We are going to try and schedule a time with the Library to go and view the Mansfield COA/Library and Foxboro COA. To our knowledge this is the only one in the state with both departments sharing one building.***

**Programs:**

It is our understanding that many seniors will not be able to go to Hawthorn Medical. We will try and set something up with SHINE, maybe hold it at the VFW in Freetown as the COA has limited space available.***
