NEWSLETTER LANGUAGE FOR SNOWBIRDS:

ATTN: Snowbirds

Are you a "snowbird" who seasonally lives at another address? Did you know that your information should be counted at the address where you live and sleep most of the time? If you live in Massachusetts for most of the year, you should respond to the 2020 Census addressed to your Massachusetts household. It's important to know, U.S. Census data is for statistical purposes only and your responses on the Census will not affect your property tax or insurance premiums. You will be able to fill out the U.S. Census online or over the phone at your convenience in 13 different languages. Eventually, your housing unit will receive the traditional paper form if you do not self-respond using the online or phone method. This information is used for data for the next 10 years, money for state and federal programs, and your political representation. All of your information is strictly confidential and will not be shared with any federal or state agency under Title 13 of the U.S. Code. The Census Bureau will never ask for your full Social Security Number, bank accounts, or money of any kind. The Inspector General for the Social Security Administration, Gail S. Ennis, and Commissioner of Social Security Andrew Saul announce the launch of a dedicated online form at https://oig.ssa.gov to receive reports from the public of Social Security-related scams. These scams—in which fraudulent callers mislead victims into making cash or gift card payments to avoid arrest for purported Social Security number problems-skyrocketed over the past year to become the #1 type of fraud reported to the Federal Trade Commission and the Social Security Administration.

To combat these scams, the Office of the Inspector General (OIG) will use the new online form to capture data that will be analyzed for trends and commonalities. The OIG will use the data to identify investigative leads, which could help identify criminal entities or individuals participating in or facilitating the scams. Ultimately, these efforts are expected to disrupt the scammers, helping reduce this type of fraud as well as the number of victims.

"We are taking action to raise awareness and prevent scammers from harming Americans," said Commissioner Saul. "I am deeply troubled that our country has not been able to stop these crooks from deceiving some of the most vulnerable members of our society."
