
FREETOWN TO A FR



FCC Meeting Minutes 1/5/23

This meeting was held at the Freetown Police station in the meeting/community room.

Present were Nicole Davignon, Jeannine Ludocivitz, John Remedis, Sara Dudley, Courtney Brightman, Jay Michaels and Abby Michaels from the Council. Also present were Grace Mederios and Diane Balestracci from the Freetown Senior Club.

The meeting was called to order at 6:10pm.

The minutes from the previous meetings were read and unanimously approved.

There was a discussion about passing the annual Tree lighting event over to the selectmen. No further action on this was taken.

The council then went on to discuss the 2023 grant applications. Council treasurer Courtney went over the available funds from the treasury. The council received \$7,300 from the state and had \$6,300 available (unencumbered) and so had a total of \$13,600 available in total for grants for fiscal year 2023.

Nicole Davignon put the list of grant applicants on the projector from the MCC grant page. There was a total of \$18,000 requested so we could not fund all requests in total.

Because there were members of the Senior club present, we had a unanimous vote to discuss that grant first. Grace Mederios and Diane Balestracci spoke briefly about the Freetown Senior Club and what the funds requested were for. Nicole made a motion to fund the club the full amount of \$1960, Sarah seconded and that passed unanimously.

Grace Mederios and Diane Balestracci then left the meeting.

The Council had a short discussion of our guidelines for grantees on our MCC page and also what criteria to sort the grants into. We then sorted the grants on the whiteboard according to those (a primary list for those who best fit the criteria and a secondary list). The votes were as follows:

Courtney went through and posted our approvals on the MCC website. The council set a date for our next meeting for March 21st at 6pm to discuss a possible Easter event and the Art Show.
