The increase from March to April's number was explained by the required local contribution by the state increasing for both towns. The per pupil cost rose to \$30.00 from \$20.00. Ashley stated that if Senate numbers change in the mean time, she will provide updated information to both committees.

Ashley went over the intricate details of the budget such as teacher salaries, and the cost of books for advanced placement classes.

Richard explained that the region a has a growing population of English language learners, more students with more needs. stating he believes we're going to see more students going forward with continued need for additional resources. Also, through the census we can anticipate that the onboarding kindergarten need will keep going up. We currently have 5 sections and we're going to need an
