Minutes of the Water & Sewer Commission meeting 4/10/2017

6:30PM

Meeting called to order by Bob Parker

Members present:

Discussion with City of Fall River Water Department Representatives Terry Sullivan, John Friar, Paul Ferland

- Terry Sullivan discussed improvements to Fall River water system.
- John Friar will coordinate all flushing and bleeding/daily usage with the Town of Freetown.
 - 0 Flushing and bleeding of lines in Assonet up to 220,000 GPD allowed.
 - Fall River recommends FW&SC install a 1 ½" meter for flushing/bleeding off a 0 hydrant for 20 gallons per minute (GPM) to prevent failure of the meter. Using a diffuser with indicator.
 - FW&SC to create a flush & bleed plan and send to John Friar for review. 0
 - Allow Fall River access to meters.
 - Request Freetown collect reading data be done on the same day as FR reads and 0
- FR developed a high pressure zone and tank at this site with 120psi.
- Innovation Way/Industrial Park area
 - Current average pressure in the industrial park is now 50-70psi for the incline. 0
 - City of Fall River looking into installing a pressure reducing valve at Innovation 0
 - Way at Town line. Looking into a MassSave grant program to help finance. 0
 - Redevelopment Authority has a 90 acre +/- plot that they are actively looking 0 to develop.
- Keven to draft a flushing/bleeding plan and submit to John Friar.
 - Keven to give John Friar time when he will be flushing/bleeding each location.
 - Fall River will supply the FW&SC with a spreadsheet for tracking readings for each location at the end of each month.
- Potential industrial growth in Freetown will increase water usage benefitting both Freetown and Fall River.

Commissioners sign copies of contract for CN Corp who is doing work on emergency by-pass valve project.

Brad Paiva makes a motion to adjourn. Paul Sadeck 2nd. All in favor. Motion carried.
