Notice of Vacancy
Conservation Commission – Alternate Members

Notice is hereby given that vacancies exist for two Alternate Members for the Conservation Commission for one-year terms expiring June 30, 2022.

The Conservation Commission oversees local compliance with the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act. It also oversees compliance with any application local rules, regulations, or by-laws related to wetlands and wetlands protection. Additionally, the Conservation Commission is the steward of the majority of protected, open space owned and maintained by the Town of Freetown.

An Alternate Member is akin to a substitute member, and may be asked to participate in deliberations when a regular member is absent, unable to act, or has a conflict of interest, or if there is a vacancy on the commission until the vacancy is filled.

The Conservation Commission is a volunteer committee. Members must be available for weekday evening meetings, typically two evenings per month.
