Review of draft lease proposal from the James White Building Trustees: A discussion took place regarding various aspects of the lease. The current proposal does not address the items/concerns previously discussed with the Building Trustees. Chairperson Linda Fournier to contact the Building Trustees and share our concerns over this proposal.

New Business:

Discuss donating items in the attic of the Hathaway Library to the Historical Society: Currently there are 70 items that maybe of interest to the Historical Society. After discussion it was decided that the library would loan these items to the historical society if they are interested in them. A letter from the Historical Society stating their interest in these items would be requested. The library will develop a letter stating that this is a loan to the Historical Society—this will need to be approved by the selectmen. Nicole to follow-up with the Historical Society.

Discuss MA Public Library Construction Program and proposal for Library Building Plan: The new Construction Grant Round will begin this year- Letter of Intent needs to be submitted by April 28, 2023. This grant can be utilized for a shared building project. Part of the application process is the submission of a building program. The trustees reviewed the material submitted by Mary Braney – a Library Consultant for Library Planning and Program Development. A motion

made by Paul Sadeck and seconded by Irene Ashley to contract with Mary Braney to write the building program for the Freetown Public Libraries. The motion passed.
