- Call to Order: Chairperson Paul Sadeck called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. Mr. Sadeck is recording the meeting.

- Review of Payroll: Payroll for September was reviewed. There were no questions or discussion.
- Review of Bills: Bills for September were reviewed. There were no questions or discussion.
- Review of Minutes: The minutes for September 28, 2023 were reviewed. On a motion made by Linda Fournier and seconded by Courtney Brightman the minutes were accepted. The motion passed.

Mr Pilling has offered to draft a new letter to outline the agreement between the Freetown Library and the Historical Society. The proposed letter is to be reviewed at the next meeting of the Library Trustees.
