Rather than having a lease (that lasts for 20 years) they will now be licensing the fields, which will be better for all of the teams. Jeff's new role is to be in charge of the boat ramp and beach. The Beach gate is now open for the season and won't be closed until the end of the season. He is also hiring some new parking attendants for the Boat ramp.
