Minutes of previous meeting of 5/26/22 reviewed.

Discussed the schedule of who, what, when for the Strawberry Festival on 6/19. Judy asked if we could vote on purchasing 4 - 6' folding tables for P&F's usage. Motion was made, voted on, and passed.
