Mission Statement

To develop educational tools, partnerships and conservation programs which will help the Town of Freetown restore, protect and preserve the community's natural resources, landscape and wildlife, thereby cultivating a healthier environment and more sustainable, cost efficient way of life for all its habitants.

Membership

The committee will be comprised of 7 members who wish to volunteer their knowledge, time and efforts toward achieving a clean, healthy living environment and experience for all citizens in the community. The make-up of the Freetown Clean Community Advocates will be as follows: a representative from the Conservation Commission, Planning Board and Board of Selectmen, and a resident from each of the 3 voting precincts. At-large positions will fill the remaining seats on the committee.

Action Items

1. Take actions toward achieving Green Community Status
2. Network and develop partnerships with other like-minded groups and communities to learn ways we can continue to cultivate and foster a truly clean, healthy environment.
3. Promote healthy practices & programs – eliminating standing water, responsible waste reduction and disposal, Mass Saves Energy Efficiency program, etc.
4. Develop educational and engaging programs within the community, such as an Agricultural Exchange Program (composting kits, community garden, etc.).
5. Other ideas as developed and vetted to town officials/residents.
