PLANNING BOARD NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with the Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 40A Section 9 and the Town of Freetown Protective Bylaws, Article 11 Section 17, the Planning Board, acting as the Special Permit Granting Authority, will hold a public hearing to review the application of **Industrial Communications LLC/Town of Freetown** for a **special permit** as per the attached notice:

The Town of Freetown Planning Board will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, March 3, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. at the Freetown Council on Aging, 227 Chace Road, East Freetown, MA 02717 to act on the petition of Industrial Communications LLC/Town of Freetown. The petitioner is requesting a special permit in order to construct a 180' communications tower for the Freetown Police Station with future expansion for wireless carriers located at 15 Memorial Drive East Freetown, MA (Assessors Map 239, Lot 31, Owner: Town of Freetown) located in the Residential Zoning District.

The petitioners are requesting a **special permit** for an antenna that is in excess of one hundred feet. Article 11, Section 11.17 states that height requirements for antennas, water tanks, chimneys, towers, spires, and the like as well as other structural features not used for human occupancy that are in excess of one hundred feet shall require the granting of a special permit by the Planning Board.

A copy of the application and plans may be viewed at the Planning Board Office and Town Clerk's office during normal Town Hall hours. All persons, parties or corporations interested therein may appear and be heard in relation thereto.
