

Planning Board Minutes - May 28, 2013

A meeting of the Town of Freetown **Planning Board** was held on **May 28, 2013** at the Freetown Town Hall, 3 North Main Street, Assonet, MA. **Present**: Chairman Robert Raymond, Mark Rogers, Keven Desmarais (7:16).

A. Continued Public Hearing for the Niemiec Solar Array on 27 Locust Street called to order by Chairman Raymond (7:18)

Applicant is asking for approval to meet the state's deadline for solar project credits. Nick Dufresne of Thompson Farland presented the following revisions made after discussion with lot 46 abutters:

- Vinyl stockade fence along lot 46 property line
- 26 screening trees planted 6ft on center along line shared with lot 45
- Barbed wire taken off the fence

Discussion was opened to the public, which included several abutters, and an attorney for an abutter. The following issues were addressed:

- Re: moving the inverter further from shared property lines, the applicant is amenable pending NSTAR allowance
- Re: security lights at night; there will be none
- Re: visual buffer for 29 Locust, 5ft privets will be planted, but a stockade fence will not be put up in that area as panels will be very viewable
- Re: project decommission, the Niemiecs will take responsibility for dismantling the system

The board decided on the following conditions to the plan:

- 1. Electric conduits must be placed underground
- 2. The inverter on the easterly part of the site shall be no closer to the abutting neighbors than as shown on plan.
- 3. Every effort should be made to move the inverters shown on plan further away from the abutting easterly properties.
- 4. The inverters shall be sound shielded with a stockade fence.
- 5. The privet trees that shall serve as a visual buffer shall be at least 5 ft tall at the time of installation, and be replaced as needed.
- 6. Slats shall be added to the fence along the northerly property line from the northeast corner to the westerly end of the barn on Assessors lot 47.
- 7. A contaminate spill kit shall be available on site during construction.
- 8. A final as-built plan will be submitted by applicants and reviewed by the town's consulting engineer, showing as-built topography, panel layouts, raingardens, all access ways, fencing, and utilities above and under ground

Mr. Raymond entertained a motion to close public hearing; motion made by Mr. Desmarais, seconded by Mr. Rogers.

Motion to accept plan with stated conditions: Keven Desmarais; Second: Mark Rogers; unanimously voted. (8:13 PM)

B. Motion to accept proposed minor changes to the 67 Chase Rd solar array as stated in letter from Borrego dated May 17, 2013: Mark Rogers; Second: Keven Desmarais; voted unanimously.

Meeting Adjourned 8:30 PM
