The Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP) is the only federal program specifically targeted to serve older adults seeking employment and training assistance. This is a Title 5 job training program. Our core target is the mature worker population age 55 and older.

To be on this program, you have to be 55 years or older and 125% poverty level. You have to be unemployed and also meet income requirements and legally eligible to work in the U. S. We pay \$11.00 per hour for 20 hours per week paid bi-weekly.

We place participants in nonprofit or government agencies in a working training capacity where they can obtain new skills that will make them more marketable for employment with an unsubsidized setting.
