

Cell Phone/Electronic Devices Policy

The Freetown Public Libraries prohibits the use of audible devices without headphone or with headphones set at a volume that disturbs others. Using cell phones, pagers, and other communication devices in a manner that disturbs others is also prohibited. Cell phone and pager audible ringers must be shut off when practical or should be set to the shortest, least obtrusive audible alarm possible. If the conversation is going to be long in nature, we encourage that the call is made/taken outside of the library.
