Freetown Public Libraries Computer and Internet Use Agreement

In keeping with its mission the Freetown Public Libraries provides access to the Internet and public computers to support the educational, informational, and recreational needs of the community.

<u>Use of library computers indicates that users have read and agree to this policy and the</u> conditions listed below.

Internet access may only be used for legal and appropriate purposes.

Examples of **unacceptable** purposes include, but are not limited to:

- Any use that violates copyrights, patent protections or license agreements.
- Attempts to gain unauthorized access to information systems or violate the privacy of others.
- Viewing material that violates federal, state or local laws or regulations, including those regarding accessing, viewing, printing and distributing child pornography.
- Tampering with or damaging library equipment, software, or data, including attempting to install unauthorized software, or disconnecting library computers.
- Impeding the computing activities of others.

Use by Children

The Freetown Public Libraries do not monitor or filter access to the internet. As with other library materials restrictions of a child's access to content is the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian. Children twelve (12) and under who wish to use the public computers **MUST** be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

Printing

Printing and copies are 10¢ per page. Payment will be due at time of service.
