Notice is hereby given that a vacancy exists on the Conservation Commission for a three-year term expiring June 30, 2026.

The Conservation Commission oversees local compliance with the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act. It also oversees compliance with any application local rules, regulations, or by-laws related to wetlands and wetlands protection. Additionally, the Conservation Commission is the steward of the majority of protected, open space owned and maintained by the Town of Freetown.

The Conservation Commission is a volunteer committee. Members must be available for weekday evening meetings, typically on Monday's, two evenings per month.
